

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE GOING TO THE RANGE

- All adults must have a government issued photo ID. Driver's license is preferred. Also acceptable is a Passport, Military ID, State ID Card or Law Enforcement ID.
- Children under 8 years old are not allowed on the property.
Children 8-13 may fire .22LR rifles.
Children 10 or older who have completed a Hunter Safety or Firearm Safety program may fire centerfire rifles – you must provide proof of completion.
Children 14 or older may fire centerfire rifles and handguns.
- Dogs are not allowed on the property (except service animals and Law Enforcement K9s).
- All firearms must unloaded and in a case and only removed from the case at the bench during a “hot” range with the muzzle pointed down range.
- Leave all firearms in your vehicle until after you check in.
- This is a “cold” range - meaning all firearms must be clear (unloaded and no magazine inserted). There is a safe area inside the gate to clear your firearms when you arrive and reload when you leave.
- Eye and ear protection is required for everyone on the range.
- Only paper targets are allowed.
- The Range does not sell ammunition or sell/rent firearms.
- The Range does have targets and chamber flags for sale.
